Head Teacher's Comments

The PFA met this week and, as ever, are working hard to plan more events for children and families. They are a great team and are 100% focused on improving opportunities for you children. The team and I are working together preparing a new set of termly targets for school development and this initiative has been praised by school improvement colleagues as it demonstrates a collaborative and focused approach to whole school improvement. By completing a 'Focus of the Term' we are able to pinpoint specific developments aimed at improving your child's progress and development.

A further school improvement visit took place this week from our curriculum governor leaders. There is a lot of experience on this committee and this week the monitoring visit looked at how we are developing our teaching and learning in maths across the whole school. 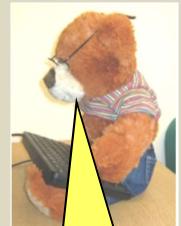
