Across the school the staff planned activities that covered a whole range of topics from electronics to structures. The success of this day was down to the staff who planned exciting activities and the children who participated brilliantly. We are all committed to providing your children with a creative and exciting curriculum. It is always a pleasure to find hidden talents in our children and days like these help us to find those talents.

We had a visit from a senior teacher from Queen Katherine School (QKS) this week, to talk to our KS2 children about transition to secondary school. I hope some of you were able to attend the movie night at The Lakes School yesterday or will be going to the Disco tonight, as these are great opportunities to get to know possible future secondary schools for your children.

It was a pleasure to support South Lakes District Council this week as they are looking to develop the Windermere Park for our community and want to involve our children. A small group of KS1 and KS2 children spent some time with staff from SLDC on Thursday. Your children have some fantastic and creative ideas.

During this term KS2 are studying some topics for life regarding personal safety and I have chosen topics that are relevant to our children. 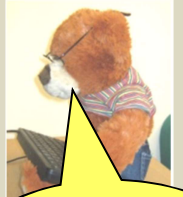
