## **Vision Statement for Primary PE and Sport Premium 2017**

All pupils leave primary school physically literate and with the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport. We endeavor to provide a range of broad activities both on site and off site. We have developed positive working relationships with the local Rugby club and use their facilities. Environmental learning activities take place in a variety of settings in our local environment and through our strong community links.

### **Objective**

To achieve self-sustaining improvement in the quality of PE and Sport at St Cuthbert's Catholic Primary School. To include:

- the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity thus kick starting healthy active lifestyles
- the profile of PE and Sport being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement
- increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
- broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
- increased participation in competitive sport
- Making sport and PE an enjoyable experience.

The key priority for 2017 to 2018 is to use the Sport Premium Funding to allow greater opportunities for pupils to participate in cluster sporting competitions.

How we used our Sports Premium Funding:

Specialist sports coaching £3,712.50	<p>All children access specialist coaching. Our coach supports all staff in developing our PE curriculum</p> <p>Impact – All children accessing a broader range of PE skills with a specialist</p>
Swimming lessons £2,020	<p>Children have had access to a swimming pool and specialist swimming teachers.</p> <p>Impact – All children will leave school in KS2 as competent swimmers in two basic strokes. Children will be water safe.</p>
Transport costs to participate in sporting events £250	<p>Children have had the opportunity to travel to local sporting events. Some transport has been provided by our local secondary schools and appreciated.</p>
Development of PE and outdoor play equipment £3,497.71	<p>We have introduced new sporting activities and games across all key stages in the school.</p> <p>Impact - We have developed the sports and play equipment so that children now have safer and better quality items to use in their lessons. As a result of this expenditure, we have been able to offer more after school sporting clubs.</p>
