Sports Funding Impact Statement for 2017 to 2018

- The school has participated more in cluster school tournaments, these have included:
 - Two cross country festivals, dance festivals, Quicksticks Hockey, football, Tri-golf, athletics.
 - A focus has been to release staff to support and learn from these events
- We have developed our outdoor adventure activities: Footprint outdoor games; Adventure days (liaising with secondary schools)
- The school makes more effective use of the grounds at Windermere Rugby Club
- Y5 children took part in a sports leadership/coaching program over 6 X1 weekly sessions.
- We have developed and improved our sports equipment with a greater range of activities now being taught.
- We now employ two sports specialists on a part-time basis to lead our sports and PE activities. Staff gain valuable continued professional development from these coaches.
- Children have participated in two dance festivals having been taught by a specialist dance teacher.
- KS2 children continue their swimming provision so that all pupils leave KS2 having met the minimum standards for national curriculum swimming. All pupils can:
 - Swim 24 metres; use a range of strokes; perform a self-rescue.
- Participation of pupils is monitored closely by the school (spreadsheet tracks individual pupil's participation in sporting events.

Out of 64 children:

264 participations have been made (at the time of writing this statement)

100% participation in events by our Pupil Premium children

100% participation by our Educational Health Care Plan children

Boys and girls are participating in equal measure

Sustaining these improvements.

1. Children in KS2 will continue to swim using the local outdoor swimming pool.
2. The school will continue to make effective use of sports coaches to help develop our specialist coaching and staff professional development.
3. Links with Windermere Rugby Club and other local sporting agencies will be developed to continue to broaden our sporting provision and range of opportunities.
4. The school is going to link with the local church toddler group to engage them in sporting activities at the school to offer community support to this group.
5. We are now participating in more tournaments and these must be sustained in the forthcoming year.
6. It is important to identify and participate in activities that support children who are less willing to take part in sporting events. (See 3)
7. The school needs to explore opportunities for children linked to watersports events taking into account our unique area.
8. School to sustain these improvements by maintaining close working relationships with local secondary school and primary partners.
