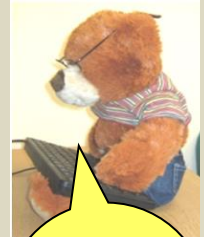
I hope you have a lovely summer break and we look forward to welcoming you back on September 7th.
