Below are the topics that we are going to be studying this half term with some ideas of activities you can do at home to support your child's learning.

Subjects	EYFS (Nursery and Reception)	How to help at home.
Religious Education	Galilee to Jerusalem We will be focusing on the early life of Jesus and his life as a young Jewish boy. We will also look at how Jesus met some of the special people in his life	The Holy Family. Write a prayer for your family. Why not bring it into school and share with Mrs Bone for our RE corner?
Communication and Language CATHO	The children will have the opportunity to spend time in focused learning time with an adult and questions to find out more and to check they understand what has been said to them. They will be able to consolidate this new understanding and vocabulary in continuous provision with their peers. The children will be encouraged to articulate their ideas and thoughts in well-formed sentences always modeled correctly by staff.	Read the same books together at home so that the children learn the repeated refrains by heart and join in with the parts they know. Traditional tales such as Goldilocks, Three Billy Goats Gruff etc are particularly good for this.
Personal Social and Emotional Development	This half term, the children will focus on building resilience and perseverance. We will discuss what it means to 'try our best' and know that it is okay if we find something tricky. The children will learn strategies to help them if their emotions are feeling overwhelming.
