*'Friday 14th June 2024 marks the 60th anniversary of the dedication of Our Lady of Windermere & St Herbert's!*

*To celebrate our Jubilee, there will be a special Mass at 6.30pm that day, followed by refreshments after Mass in the form of a Jacob's Join in the church hall, at approximately 7.30pm.*

*So, put that date, Friday 14th June in your diary.*

*All parishioners of Our Lady of Windermere and Mater Amabilis in Ambleside, are most welcome to the Mass, as are visitors and all who love our church.*

*The Bishop will be concelebrating Mass with Fr Ajish and former parish priests.*

*But before we get to this auspicious date, some work needs to be done so as to make this very special one-off event a wonderful experience for all.*

*Some jobs need to take place well in advance, and some near to, or on the day itself. A special insert for the newsletter with more details about arrangements and how you can help will appear in the next couple of weeks.'*

I would love to have as many children from school at mass as possible. Their behaviour in church is impeccable and I would be very proud for Bishop Paul to see how amazing they are.

You can either leave your child / children with us during the celebrations or you would also be welcome to join us, sitting close by.

#### Details of the event are as follows:

- Children should be in full uniform.
- Meet on the school playground between 18.00-18.10, where we will walk from school to church and join the Bishop, Father Ajish and the Parishioners for this joyful occasion. (If you arrive after 18.10, you can join us in church, no problem)
- After Mass (approx. 19.30) we are invited to join everyone for refreshments in the Parish Hall. We will not be able to supervise children in the hall, but you are encouraged to join in the celebrations as a family. Children should be collected from us at 19.30 from Church.
