This week we have celebrated National Science week in school, completing lots of Science related activities. As part of their 'sensational salads' topic, the Explorers have been observing the growth of the beans they planted last week also learning about what plants need to make them grow. They've also been investigating potatoes, they enjoyed planting them and using them to paint with.







Y3&4 have made 'eat well' plates and have been sorting foods into their food groups. Y5&6 have been learning about the aging process and different life milestones in age brackets.
